General information

- Application deadline: 15th February, 12:00 noon
- > Available funds:
 - Funds for research: 7.5 MDKK (TBC)
 - Funds for Work Life Research: up to 2.5 MDKK
 - Max. 2/3 of budget funding from the Research Council
 - Funding range: min. 300,000 DKK, max. 1 MDKK, (max. 1.5 MDKK for PhD)
- > Funding may be granted for research:
 - carried out by a Faroese researcher, or
 - carried out in cooperation with a Faroese research institute, or
 - considered significant in a Faroese context



Scope – Funds for Research

> Bottom-up initiatives:

- Funding may be granted for nearly all research areas
- Yet, preferably related to or expanding present research areas in the Faroe Islands
- Funding may be granted for basic and applied research:
 - PhD projects
 - Projects spanning a minimum of 6 months
 - Industrial R&D projects

Scope – Work Life Research

- Projects on work life in the Faroe Islands must be of gain to the future Faroese labour market.
- Projects may cover the labour market in general, or aspects relating to employees in a certain industry or field of work.
- The research is required to cover either a topic relevant for labour market stakeholders, or other work related areas warranting further investigation.
- Funding may be granted for:
 - PhD projects
 - Projects spanning a minimum of 6 months

Priorities

- Advantage is given to projects that strengthen the Faroese research community with:
 - data and lasting knowledge and skills
 - cooperation between various researchers/research entities and/or businesses
 - international cooperation and mobility

Project types

PhD projects

- Funding for 3 year PhD projects
- Enrollment at University, preferably in cooperation with other institutions

Bachelor

- At least two supervisors
- Research stay at other location part of the project
- Postdoc and industrial projects
 - Project leader must be a researcher

Formal requirements

- > Applications must be submitted via <u>umsokn.com</u>
- > All core texts in English
- Project length: min. 6 months, max. 4 years, start date 1st August 2023 or later
- Project consortium with Institution/Company, Project Leader and other key persons
- Summary of the Project, Communication Plan, Data Management Plan, Ethics & Legal Framework, and References

Formal requirements 2

> Enclosures:

- Project Description and Management Plan (Please use template)*
- Budget, CV, Letters of Commitment *
- Ethics, Diplomas (if relevant)
- Adjustments this round
 - Provide 3-5 keywords describing the project in order of importance
 - Suggest max. 3 peers, who we could ask to evaluate
 - Provide details, if a similar application has been submitted before
 - Note, that the max. length of enclosed documents is adjusted
- > Please consult the Terms of Reference

Tips for applicants

- Submit a (next to) final version of your proposal several days before the deadline
- Do not edit the proposal in more than one browser tab/window at the same time
- Write the text for the portal fields in a text editor, save on your PC, and copy/paste to the application portal
- Save your changes in the portal! Data is saved automatically, but you can also click on save manually cat for proposals 2022: Funds for Research
- Name your enclosures according to type (project description, management plan etc.) and with acronym
- > Do not encrypt or digitally sign your pdf files
- Double-check after upload of files, whether the entire application can be opened without problems and that all files are shown correctly, before you submit the final application.
